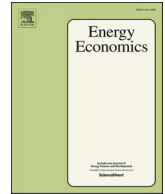

1. Best paper awards

The most-cited paper published in *Energy Economics* in 2020 is *How do environmental regulation and environmental decentralization affect green total factor energy efficiency: Evidence from China* by Haitao Wu, Yu Hao and Siyu Ren.

The most-cited paper published in 2017 is *Energy consumption, financial development and economic growth in India: New evidence from a nonlinear and asymmetric analysis* by Muhammad Shahbaz, Thi Hong Van Hoang, Mantu Kumar Mahalik and David Roubaud.

Each paper will be awarded a \$1000 prize.

An honorary mention goes to *Oil price shocks and stock market activity*

by Perry Sadorsky, which is the first *Energy Economics* paper to be cited more than 1000 times.

The top reviewers in 2021 were Yue-Jun Zhang, Xu Gong and Yu Hao.

Each referee will be awarded a \$250 prize.
