Curriculum Vitae

Judith Rietdijk is geboren op 3 maart 1981 te Naarden. Na het behalen van haar middelbareschooldiploma aan de SG Huizermaat te Huizen studeerde zij journalistiek aan de Hogeschool van Utrecht. Met het bachelor diploma journalistiek op zak, werkte zij voor een lokaal weekblad, terwijl zij daarnaast psychologie studeerde aan de Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam. Haar interesse voor psychose en prepsychose is gewekt tijdens de masterstage, die zij vervulde op een ambulante afdeling voor psychotische patiënten bij Parnassia. Hier schreef zij ook haar masterthese over zorgwensen, het tegemoet komen aan deze wensen door hulpverleners en de (associatie met) kwaliteit van leven van patiënten met schizofrenie. In 2007 studeerde Judith af in de afstudeerrichting Klinische Psychologie. Na nog een paar maanden te hebben gewerkt op een afdeling voor ouderen met psychiatrische problemen, heeft Judith gekozen voor een carrière in de vroegdetectie. Zij werd aangenomen als promovendus op de EDIE-studie, resulterend in dit proefschrift.

Judith Rietdijk was born on the 3th of March in Naarden, the Netherlands. After her graduation from high school, she studied Journalism at the HU Utrecht (bachelor). She completed this study in 2003 and started working as a Journalist at a local newspaper. Simultaneously she studied Psychology at the VU University in Amsterdam. During her masters she obtained her first experience with schizophrenia patients and she became interested in working with (pre) psychotic patients. During this job she also explored the association between care desires and quality of life in schizophrenia patients. In 2007 she finished her masters in Clinical Psychology and started working as psychologist with elderly psychiatric patients. However, after a few months she choose to start a career in the early detection and prevention of psychosis and applied for a PhD-student position, resulting in the current dissertation.
