Special collections

Bonnier papers (Institut français d'architecture, Centre d'archives d'architecture du XX^e siècle, Paris): personal records of French architect and planner Louis Bonnier, active member of the IFHTP, only contains few references to the the IFHTP.

Garden City Museum (Letchworth): a varied collection of press cuttings and publications on the origins of the garden city movement in general and Letchworth Garden City in particular.

Granpré Molière papers (Netherlands Architecture Institute, Rotterdam): personal records of Dutch architect Marinus Jan Granpré Molière, active member of the IFHTP, only contains few references to the the IFHTP.

Gurlitt papers (Technical University, Dresden): personal records of Cornelius Gurlitt, rector of the technical university of Dresden, president of the Society of German Architects, and prominent active member of the IFHTP. The records do not contain references to the IFHTP.

Howard papers (HALS, Hertford): personal records of Ebenezer Howard, the godfather of the garden city movement, contains amongst others paper cuttings, drafts, personal notes, minutes, reports and photos with regard to Howard's involvement in the garden city movement, including the IFHTP.

IFHP archives (International Federation for Housing and Planning, The Hague): collection of the IFHP (present incarnation of the IFHTP), contains minutes, correspondence, reports, drafts, publications, et cetera. The collection covers the period 1919 up to the present, but has no documentation for the period 1940-1945. With regard to the period before the Second World War, the collection basically only contains minutes of meetings.

ILO archives (International Labour Office, Geneva): a vast and varied collection of reports, periodicals, publications, press cuttings on labour issues, including adjoining fields such as public housing, local governance and (to a lesser extent) town planning, also includes notes, correspondence, drafts et cetera with regard to the work of the ILO.

IVWS archives (Municipal Archive, Stuttgart): extensive archive of the IFHTP under the presidency of Strölin (1938-1945), including documentation of German participation from 1933 onwards. Archive contains minutes, correspondence, IFHTP periodicals and newsletters, drafts, personal notes, etcetera.

Jaussely papers (Institut français d'architecture, Centre d'archives d'architecture du XX^e siècle, Paris): personal records of French architect and planner Leon Jaussely, regular visitor of IFHTP congresses, only contains few references to the the IFHTP.

Jeserich papers (Bundesarchiv, Koblenz): personal records of Kurt Jeserich, director of the *Deutsche Gemeindetag* and vice-president of the UIV and IIAS in the 1930s, does not contain references to the IFHTP.

Keppler papers (International Institute for Social History, Amsterdam): personal records of Arie Keppler, prominent active Dutch member in the IFHTP, only contains few references to the IFHTP.

NIROV archives (Netherlands Architecture Institute, Rotterdam): old records of the NIROV and its previous incarnation NIVS, contains a lot of documentation (minutes, correspondence, questionnaires, reports, drafts et cetera) about Dutch participation in the IFHTP.

NIROV library (Netherlands Architecture Institute, Rotterdam): old library of the NIROV and its previous incarnation NIVS, offers congress reports of the IFHTP and the International Housing Congresses. At the time of this research this library was located at the library of the

Ministry of Housing, Spatial planning and Environment (VROM), now it is located at the Netherlands Architecture Institute.

Pepler papers (Strathclyde University, Glasgow): personal records of George Pepler, one of the most influential active members of the IFHTP, includes correspondence, articles, drafts, reports, photos and personal notes with regard to Pepler's involvement in the IFHTP. The records mainly cover the period after 1945. These records do contain a nearly complete set of the pre-war Bulletins of the IFHTP.

Prost papers (Institut français d'architecture, Centre d'archives d'architecture du XX^e siècle, Paris): personal records of French architect and planner Henri Prost, regular visitor of IFHTP congresses, only contains few references to the the IFHTP.

Société du Logement de la Région Bruxelles-Capitale (Brussels): library of one of the successors of the Société Nationale des Habitations et Logements à Bon Marché (this parental organisation was split into three organizations due to the federalization of Belgium, one for flanders, one for Wallone and one for Brussels) contains the archives of the Société Nationale des Habitations et Logements à Bon Marché and the Institut National des Habitations et Logements à Bon Marché, Belgian orgnaisations that participated in the IFHTP. These archives contain no references to the IFHTP.

Strölin papers (Municipal Archive, Stuttgart): personal records of Karl Strölin, president of the IFHTP in the period 1938-1945, includes diaries, correspondence, notes, articles, drafts and photos with regard to the IFHTP.

Stübben papers (Historical Archive of the City of Cologne, Cologne): personal records of Hermann Joseph Stübben, prominent German planning pioneer an regular visitor of IFHTP congresses, contains paper cuttings, (draft) reports and some photos relating to IFHTP congresses.

TCPA collection (Town and Country Planning Association, London): the collection of the TCPA, the present monicker of the GCTPA, does not contain records concerning the IFHTP.

According to the librarian all records relating to the IFHTP have been disposed. The collection does offer a complete set of *Garden cities and town planning* and *Town and country planning*, the periodical of the TCPA, which proved to be a valuable source for this research, especially with regard to the formative years of the IFHTP (1913-1920).

Sellier papers (Municipal archive, Suresnes): personal records of Henri Selleir, prominent active member of the IFHTP, only contains few references to the the IFHTP.

TPI collection (Royal Town Planning Institute, London): the collection of the TPI does not contain records concerning the IFHTP. According to the librarian all records relating to the IFHTP have been disposed. The collection does offer a complete set of the *Journal of the Town Planning Institute*, which proved to be a valuable source for this research, especially with regard to the inter-war period.

Tyrwhitt papers (Reading Room RIBA, London) : personal records of Jacqueline Tyrwhitt, contains personal notes about some post-World War II congresses of the IFHTP and correspondence concerning collaboration with the IFHTP in the far east after the Second World War.

Tyrwhitt papers (Strathclyde University, Glasgow): personal records of Jacqueline Tyrwhitt, contains no documentation with regard to the IFHTP.

Union des Villes and des Communes Belges (UVCB, Brussels): an inquiry by telephone leads to the conclusion that all documentation with regard to participation of the UVCB in the IFHTP in the period 1913-1945 is lost.

Unwin papers (Reading room RIBA, London): personal records of Raymond Unwin, only contains a few references to the IFHTP.

Van Eesteren papers (Netherlands Architecture Institute, Rotterdam): personal records of Dutch planner Cornelis van Eesteren, visitor of IFHTP congresses and president of the CIAM, only contains few references to the IFHTP.

Van Lohuizen papers (Netherlands Architecture Institute): personal records of Dutch planning pioneer Theodoor Karel van Lohuizen, contains material relating to Van Lohuizen's participation at the 1924 Amsterdam congress of the IFHTP.

Verhagen papers (Netherlands Architecture Institute, Rotterdam): personal records of Dutch planner Pieter Verhagen, visitor of and paper presenter at IFHTP congresses, only contains few references to the IFHTP congresses.

Verwilghen papers (Catholic University of Louvain, campus library Arenberg): personal records of Belgian architect planner Raphaël Verwilghen contains documentation – correspondence, reports, minutes, photos, notes – on the IFHTP.

Wibaut papers (International Institute for Social History, Amsterdam): personal records of F.M. Wibaut, only briefly active in the IFHTP, but a very influential member of the UIV, the IHC and the *Verband*. The records contain correspondence, minutes, drafts, etcetera. These records are especially interesting to study the housing controversy in the IFHTP, the history of the *Verband* and strained relations between the IFHTP and the *Verband*.
