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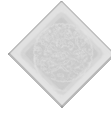

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Curriculum Vitae

Desiree J. Hooi was born on May 17th, 1982 in Willemstad, Curaçao. After obtaining her degree as a Registered Nurse at the Instituto pa Formashon den Enfermeria (IFE) on Curaçao, she worked for four years at the Taams Clinic and the first aid department at the St. Elisabeth Hospital.

In 2005, she moved to Costa Rica to study medicine at the Universidad de Ciencias Medicas (UCIMED). During her studies she gained experience in departments of Internal medicine, Surgery, Paediatrics, Gynaecology & Obstetrics, Psychiatry, Pathology & Forensic pathology, Family practice and Emergency medicine.

In 2011, she obtained her degree in medicine and returned to Curaçao where she worked for one and a half year as a family practitioner and insurance physician. She worked also for 5 months at the department of Neurology in the St. Elisabeth hospital, Willemstad Curaçao.

In November 2012, Desiree J. Hooi was approached with the request to conduct a scientific study under the female population on Curaçao. Aware of the priority and needs of local epidemiological data and medical guidelines based on evidence obtained from the local population, she gave priority to her nation and accepted the challenge.

In January 2013, she started the research at the prevention centre named Fundashon Prevenshon located in Otrobanda. She moved to the Netherlands in 2016 to analyse and to describe the findings of the research. This was done at the Pathology department of Cancer Centre Amsterdam (CCA), which is a research division of the Academic Hospital of Amsterdam UMC.

During her stay on Curaçao, Hooi has provided voluntary service to the Red Cross, Organization for diabetic patients SOKUDI, institutions for children
